Theme: Don't toss it - make art! -Sara Lindkrantz. *Spark interest on how to use waste materials!*

Medium: Used materials such as: Recyclables, post-consumer materials (no foods or liquids), scraps, fiber, plastic, glass, metal, wood, old paint, tools, junk, old stuff, treasures, pipes, PVC, toys, nothing smelly

Judge(s): TBA

Eligibility:

- Open to Students under 18 ("Students" category), and Adults over 18 ("Adults" category).
- Enter up to three (3) original pieces per entrant - **ALL ENTRIES ACCEPTED.**
- Originality: all submissions must be original works in concept, composition, and execution by the artist. Artwork must not be copied, in part or wholly, from any published or copyrighted work.
- Judge(s) have final authority on categories and criteria.

Requirements:

- Entry form and nonrefundable entry fee due by Saturday, **July 2, 2020, 4:00 p.m.**
- Fee: \$10.00 per Adult entry (limit 3 per entrant). Pay online at bowenarts.org (see Eco art page), or send check to The Bowen, PO Box 849, Dawsonville, GA 30534.
- Students under 18 are free.
- All information given on entry form as to title and price must remain same on accepted entry.
- Hanging works must be securely fastened with hanging wire, and maximum dimensions cannot exceed 48" in either height or width.
- Stand alone works (mostly 3D) must be a reasonable weight and height: less than 5 feet in height or width, and less than 50 lbs. The Bowen reserves the right to refuse the display of any unsafe or unsuitable work.

Gallery Sales: Works will be sold at the retail value stated on Entry Form. Works not for sale should be listed "NFS." Commissions for sale of works is 35% for Bowen Members and 40% for non-members. The Bowen shall collect sales tax of 7% at point of sale. Payment for works sold will be sent in approx. thirty (30) days of exhibition closing date.

Delivery: Please drop your works at The Bowen July 2, 3 or 7. Please note Art Center hours are Tuesday-Friday 10a-4p and Saturday 12-4p. We will be closed July 4. We are located between Lanier Tech and Dawson Junior High on Highway 9 North, just north of Highway 53 intersection.

Artists are encouraged to carry their own insurance. The Bowen is not responsible for work, whether damaged due to an improper hanging system as mounted on work, or otherwise.
- No work accepted for the exhibition may be withdrawn before the close of the exhibition unless as otherwise arranged between Artist and The Bowen.
- No entry will be accepted without artist's signature on this release. The Bowen has authority on final dates/times.
